Thank you for sponsoring the 6th Annual El Cajon Harley Owners Group Toys for Tots Event by donating the two \$100 free slot play certificate, \$200 gift certificate for Prime Cut Steakhouse, security camera, two tote bags, sunglasses, and t-shirt. It was only with support from sponsors like you that record success was realized: more than \$18,500 and over 3,800 toys (more than triple the 2018 results) were donated to the Marine Corps Reserves San Diego Toys for Tots Program.

The day began with registration and breakfast at event host El Cajon Harley-Davidson. As the bikes departed, with El Cajon Police Department motorcycle escort, for the Del Mar Racetrack, they rolled under a large American flag held aloft by fire apparatus from Heartland Fire and Rescue. For the first time, the Event included car clubs, which joined the motorcycles (Harley-Davidsons, Indians, Can-Am Spyders, Star, and others) at the racetrack. Prominent among the four-wheel vehicles were the San Diego Jeep Club and North County Corvette Club. Hundreds of bikes and more than 75 cars participated.

The Del Mar Thoroughbred Club pulled out all stops, adorning the track with Toys for Tots banners, providing special access and parking for the motorcycles and cars, use of the Corona Beach House patio, grandstand seating, special Riders Up in the paddock for the senior Marines, a special race (the Del Mar Toys for Tots Ride), Winners Circle presentation, and free admission to anyone, not just the event participants, donating a new unwrapped toy.

The Marine Corps Reserves 4th Medical Battalion and 4th Tank Battalion were front and center, with two tactical vehicles staged by the gates, where uniformed Marines and sailors accepted the donated toys. Volunteer sailors from Navy Base San Diego then counted and loaded the thousands of toys for transportation. Senior Marines present included the Commanding Officer and Sergeant Major, Marine Corps Air Station Miramar; Assistant Inspector-Instructor and Inspector-Instructor Sergeant Major, 4th Tank Battalion; and Inspector-Instructor and Senior Enlisted Leader, 4th Medical Battalion. Rounding out the Marine Corps presence was the 1st Marine Division Band performing patriotic music.

When all was said and done, due to the generosity of our fantastic sponsors, over 350 prizes were in the opportunity drawing. Thanks to challenge coin and breakfast sponsors (El Cajon Harley-Davidson Del Mar Thoroughbred Club; Lloyd's Collision and Paint, and El Cajon Elks 1812), 100% of all funds generated by the event were donated to Toys for Tots. The event continues growing and we already have our eyes set on next year.
